4TH ANNUAL COMMUNITY MESSIAH SING-ALONG

Over the years, many people have said, "I wish I could sing in a large choir with an orchestra" or "I've always wanted to sing in a full production of Handel's Messiah." Once again the opportunity is here and it will take a very limited time commitment. The American Guild of Organists, and the First Presbyterian Church Concert Series proudly present the fourth annual Fargo-Moorhead Community Messiah Sing-Along.

This event will be patterned after the sing-alongs of the past three years. Orchestra members and soloists will rehearse in advance of the event, then singer participants will arrive one hour before the event to rehearse the difficult sections on music. Then, at the appointed hour, the performance begins. Any individual may sing in this performance regardless of musical skill level or background, and no advance preparation is necessary. A section of the performance area will be set aside for those persons who do not wish to sing. For those who need it, child care will be provided.

The organizers have arranged to hire many of the finest orchestral musicians in the area along with the most highly recognized regional singers as soloists: Peter Halverson, Lucy Thrasher, and Daniel Gast. We invite the public to serve as the chorus for a large scale and high quality performance of Handel's oratorio masterpiece.

The performance, which is sponsored by the Red River Valley Chapter of the American Guild of Organists and the First Presbyterian Abendmusik Concert Series, will be Sunday, December 7 at 7:30 at First Presbyterian Church of Fargo (650 2nd Ave. N.). For those who wish to sing, there will be a 45 minute rehearsal at 6:30 that evening. (No other advance preparation is required)

Admission \$5.00 Performers and Audience members \$1.00 Students (any institution)

Singers may bring their own copy of Messiah or purchase a score of chorus parts prepared for the event for \$2.00. Tickets will be available at the door only. For additional information call 293-6311, Gary Thrasher
