ORGAN FEATURE

Bethesda Lutheran Church Moorhead, MN

It all began with a petition presented by the Young People's Society to the congregation at the annual meeting in 1915, that they be allowed to fund and purchase a pipe organ. The petition was granted and the group purchased a Hillgreen-Lane organ (Alliance, Ohio, 1898-1972) for a total cost of \$1900. The Society secured \$750 from the Andrew Carnegie Organ Fund and raised the required additional funds.

This organ, number 410 for the company, became one of ninety Carnegie organs in Minnesota and one of 7,689 so funded worldwide.

At the annual meeting on January 25, 1967, the congregation voted to retain the Johnson Organ Company, Fargo, North Dakota, to rebuild the now-troublesome organ at a cost of \$13,405.79. This sum was given to Bethesda by Arthur K. Klenk before his death.

Again it was voted on in August of 1992 to have the Johnson Organ Company refurbish the organ. It was funded by a \$27,500 loan and by many generous gifts to the organ fund.

The organ was rededicated by Dr. David Childs in a recital in 1993. The current organist at Bethesda Lutheran Church is Joan Bystol. (Submitted by Marge Possehl)
